Carlton J. Pinheiro Scholarship:

This \$750.00 scholarship will be awarded by the Herreshoff Museum annually to a graduating high school senior who plans to further his/her education at an accredited college/university and pursue studies in education, history, museum/curatorial studies, English, British/American literature, or marine studies. DEADLINE: May 14, 2010

****National Coalition of 100 Black Women/RI Chapter Scholarship:**

Criteria: 1) Must be a Rhode Island resident; 2) Minimum GPA of C-; 3) Must have three (3) letters of reference; 4) College classes must commence with the current calendar year of the award; 5) Active in community through volunteer service. See Mrs. Calderone in the Guidance Dept. for an application.

DEADLINE: May 15, 2010

****New England Counselors of Color Bridging Access to College (NECBAC) Scholarship:**

Criteria: 1) New England students who will be enrolling full time in a four-year NECBAC member institute; 2) write an essay, and 3) submit an official transcript. See Mrs. Calderone in the Guidance Dept. for an application

DEADLINE: May 15, 2010

AES Engineers Scholarship:

The applicants are not required to be taking Engineering courses to be eligible. Students must submit an essay of no more than 1000 words in answer to one of the two questions that are posted on the site:

****Paul Sherlock Scholarship:**

Criteria: 1) Must be a Rhode Island resident; 2) Must be a graduate from a Rhode Island high school, or, have completed approved Home Schooling or a GED; 3) Must provide proof of acceptance as a full time student at a nationally accredited 2 or 4-year college, university or proprietary school; 4) Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit their most recent copy of their Student Aid Report (SAR) or your on-line FAFSA confirmation page. **To qualify, your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) must be \$7500 or less.**

DEADLINE: June 1, 2010

**** Rhode Island Italian American Hall of Fame:**

Criteria: 1) High academic achievement on the part of the male or female student; 2) Evidence of financial aid; 3) A record of outstanding athletic accomplishment in varsity level competition or similar accomplishment in acknowledged interscholastic artistic endeavor; 4) one letter of reference; 5) The applicant must be a Rhode Islander who is or will be a graduate of an accredited state high school and who is of any ethnic background, creed or color.

DEADLINE: June 25, 2010
