Criteria: 1) Must be a **CURRENT** active member of their school's SADD program. This scholarship is in memory of Katie DeCubellis, a 13 year old Narragansett student killed by a drunk driver on October 29, 1999. Each year the Foundation will provide two \$1,000 scholarships to high school seniors about to further their education in a technical program or a two or four year college program.
